These are general terms to help you in planning. Generally speaking, plants of hydric areas also do well under regular irrigation. Plants listed as mesic are usually more adaptable to extremes. Xeric plants will frequently do well under some irrigation, but are then more susceptible to disease and insect attack. We have, however, listed many plants as xeric that occur in a range from xeric to mesic. So ask for more information.
